

## TOEFL Exemptions

International applicants may be exempted from the TOEFL requirement if they provide proof of one of the following conditions:

### The applicant:

- Is a citizen of a country in which English is the official (or national) language  
Proof of citizenship must be provided such as birth certificate or passport  
Please refer to the list of countries below
- Has earned a diploma from an accredited U.S. High school  
Full-time enrollment for a minimum of three years is required
- Has earned a diploma from an accredited U.S. college or university
- Has completed one year (24 transferable credit hours) from a U.S. college or university  
Transferable credits are restricted to courses in which the applicant earned a grade of C or higher, and courses are equivalent to the program requirements
- Earned a score of 5.5 (or higher) on the IELTS
